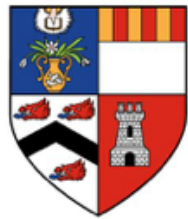


BONHOEFFER'S CONTEMPORARY VOICE:

Dietrich Bonhoeffer remains one of the most influential theological thinkers of the 20th century. Because of the eclectic and rich nature of his work, Bonhoeffer's theology invites dialogue on how his thought can shape current discussions in theology (e.g. the doctrine of God, scripture, ecclesiology, eschatology, etc.) and ethics (e.g. technology, war and violence, environmental ethics, moral deliberation, etc.)
